



Acceptable Personal Identification

1. A valid government-issued identification containing the holder's photograph and signature.
2. A valid passport of any country.
3. A declaration, with a signed certified photograph, on official, printed letterhead stationery by a mayor; lawyer; notary public; professional engineer or accountant; judge, magistrate or peace officer; manager of a bank, trust company or credit union; medical doctor or dentist; university professor or school principal; or minister of religion authorized under provincial law to perform marriages.

The following points must be included in the declaration:

- a. The declaration that he or she has known the applicant/licensee personally for at least two years; and
- b. The declaration must certify that the photograph, which must accompany the declaration, is a true photograph of the applicant/licensee; and
- c. The declaration must certify on the reverse side of the photograph that the applicants/licenses signature, which must appear on the photograph, is the candidate's true signature.
