

Hail Insurance Agent/Salesperson Qualification Exam

The Bylaws of the Hail Insurance Council of Saskatchewan require that anyone acting as a Hail Insurance Agent/Salesperson must be licensed.

The Hail Insurance Agent/Salesperson Qualification Examination consists of 40 questions including true/false and matching type questions. You must get 30 correct answers (75%) in order to pass.

The Hail Insurance Agent/Salesperson Qualification Examination is primarily based on information found in the Hail Insurance Study Guide and Hail Insurance Council of Saskatchewan Bylaws.

It is recommended that exam applicants become familiar with the above documents prior to attempting the qualification examination.

Please refer to the following material when preparing to write the Hail Insurance Agent/Salesperson Qualification Examination:

1. Hail Insurance Council Bylaws

The examination will primarily focus on Bylaws that deal with the obligations and conduct of a licensed insurance agent or salesperson.

Examination questions will be taken from the following Bylaws so make sure you have the most current copy available:

- Bylaw 2 – Licenses
- Bylaw 3 – Education requirements
- Bylaw 5 – Register and Licensing
- Bylaw 8 – Misconduct
- Bylaw 9 – Incompetence
